

Over the years, QRCS has organized several disaster management training camps, graduating hundreds of volunteers who later engaged effectively in QRCS's responses to many disasters and crises, both locally and internationally. Not only in Qatar but also regionally, DMC has become a landmark program of QRCS, eagerly awaited by many national and international government organizations and NGOs, as the only Arabic-speaking training of its kind.

EFFECTIVE PREPAREDNESS AND BETTER RESPONSE



The State of Qatar attaches great importance to the management of natural disasters, as well as international cooperation to deal with and mitigate their impact. Capacity-building is a national priority under Qatar National Vision 2030, which seeks to maintain social stability, while ensuring national preparedness.

In this context, QRCS organizes a disaster management training camp, under the slogan "Effective Preparedness and Better Response". It is seen as the MENA region's leading capacity-building program, designed to enhance the skills of disaster management specialists and train emergency personnel.



WHAT DMC FEATURES

- Specialized field training in the services provided for affected people during emergencies (shelter, WATSAN, nutrition, and health) to graduate well-trained, deployable volunteers for disaster response plans.
- Crowd management in emergencies, which enables institutions and other stakeholders to better manage disasters and incidents at public and crowded facilities.
- Qualified graduates who can respond to disasters and use disaster management tools and equipment up to international standards.
- Introduction to ERU-Field Hospital, through a full-fledged field hospital to be installed and operated on-site.
- Piloting of QRCS's emergency response plan for update and verification.
- Training to manage emergency operations and use operations room for effective coordination and response.
- Practice of simulation scenarios for region-specific disasters and response mechanism, to improve coordination with competent authorities/institutions, based on their respective role(s).
- Participation of GCC General Secretariat, ICRC, IFRC, and Arab National Societies.
- Humanitarian Tent lectures on main humanitarian topics, discussed by keynote speakers.
- Introduction to ERU-MHPSS & the services provided in emergencies.
- Introduction to ERU-WASH & the services provided in emergencies.




